

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2022 11:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Rogers and Supervisor Walker. Absent: Vice Chairperson Zumbach
(personal business). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Rogers called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to approve minutes of February 16, 2022 as
printed.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin., stated that the Board previously authorized the
notice to proceed, accepted bids and the formal contract is now complete.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to authorize Chair to sign an Agreement between
Linn County and Loecke Building Services, Inc. in the amount of \$135,600 for the
Wanatee Park Maintenance Building Office Addition project.

Public Comment: Stacey Walker commented with regard to the fire at Geneva Towers this
weekend noting that there were no deaths and minimal injuries but evacuation was
necessary. He checked with Steve O'Konek, EMA Dir., about the response to this event.
He praised EMA, Public Health, Red Cross, LIFTS, CRFD and others for their quick
response time and their efforts to take care of people in their greatest time of need.

Chairperson Rogers concurred with Walker's comments.
