

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
CEDAR RAPIDS, LINN COUNTY, IOWA  
MONDAY, JUNE 7, 2021 11:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.  
Present: Chairperson Walker, Vice Chairperson Rogers and Supervisor Zumbach. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Walker called the meeting to order.

Brent Oleson, Deputy Dir. of Public Policy & Community Relations, presented appropriation requests for economic development organizations from FY22 budgeted funds totaling \$50,000.00 (Marion Chamber - \$15,000 to \$25,000; Cedar Rapids Metro Economic Alliance - \$40,000 and MEDCO \$12,500).

Supervisor Zumbach presented the following proposal: Allocate \$40,000 to the Cedar Rapids Metro Economic Alliance and \$10,000 to MEDCO for a total of \$50,000. Rather than funding Kirkwood/Eastern Iowa Airport through this fund, fund it through the American Rescue Act (\$25,000). That will free up \$25,000 for the Marion Chamber (which they will need to apply for). The Board will discuss and decide on Wednesday.

Supervisor Rogers presented the annual Fiscal Year 2021 Eide Bailly Audit Engagement Letter. The Board will approve on Wednesday.
