

LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Walker, Vice Chairperson Rogers and Supervisor Zumbach (via phone). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Walker called the meeting to order.

Mike Tertinger, Planning & Development, discussed a Temporary Use Permit, Case JTU21-0007, Troy & Lucinda Thompson owners and petitioners, requesting permission to operate the Lost 40 Music Festival, located at 838 Bolton Manor Rd, Springville Iowa noting that they were made aware of this request Wednesday by Public Health, who was notified by the Sheriff's Office. Neither Planning nor Public Health are recommending approval of this request.

Troy Thompson and Clark Davidson (via phone) explained that 144 people have pre-registered and they are anticipating less than 250 people in attendance. Both parties apologized for not following the correct process noting that they have held this event before and were not aware of the rules.

Supervisor Walker stated that in the future he thinks there should be a process for emergency requests.

Elena Wolford, Asst. County Attorney, stated that this is not a Linn County liability. If a complaint was filed, it would be a violation of a zoning ordinance and potential fines would take place after the event is held.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to approve a Temporary Use Permit, Case JTU21-0007, Troy & Lucinda Thompson owners and petitioners, requesting permission to operate the Lost 40 Music Festival, located at 838 Bolton Manor Rd, Springville Iowa.
