MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2022 11:00 A.M.

The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Rogers, Vice Chairperson Zumbach and Supervisor Walker. Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Rogers called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to approve minutes of September 7, 2022 as printed.

Chairperson Rogers read the following Proclamation: National Preparedness Month-September 2022.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to open Public Hearing.

Brent Oleson, Deputy Dir. of Policy & Comm. Relations, presented information on the conveyance of real estate interests in the form of temporary and permanent easements and a portion in fee title of a parcel of land owned by Linn County at 650 Walford Road SW to the City of Cedar Rapids. Road construction is taking place and they asked for a portion of the county's road. Proof of publication was presented and no oral or written comments have been received.

Stephanie Lientz, Planning & Development, discussed a letter in support of a Certified Local Government Grant Application by the Linn County Historic Preservation Commission. The Board will approve Wednesday.
