City of Center Point

Summary: To authorize imposition of a local sales and services tax in the City of Center Point, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2009, until June 30, 2014.


A local sales and services tax shall be imposed in the City of Center Point, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2009, until June 30, 2014.

Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

Ten percent (10%) for Property Tax Relief; and

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are: Ninety percent (90%) for repairs, replacements, upgrades and new additions to the infrastructure systems of the City of Center Point including sanitary sewer, storm sewer, water treatment, water distribution, and streets, to include the Lewis Access Paving Project.

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City of Hiawatha

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are: Twenty-six percent (26%) trunk sewer projects, thirty-one percent (31%) road improvements, twenty percent (20%) central corridor redevelopment, ten percent (10%) parks and trail improvements and thirteen percent (13%) other community improvements, over the duration of the local option sales tax.
