Failure to secure these permits from the Linn County Public Health Department prior to beginning construction may have significant consequences and could result in the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ The installation of a more expensive non-conventional septic system. Such systems require more maintenance and generally have shorter life than a conventional system. ♦ If a conventional or non-conventional system is not feasible due to site conditions and/or the location of the building(s), an occupancy permit will not be issued. <p>Consider this as notice to contact the Linn County Health Department to secure the necessary permits.
