



# Wanatee Park



**FACILITY RENTALS** | The park has two lodges and one open shelter that are popular for family, corporate and social events. Prairie Oak Lodge and Red Cedar Lodge are both equipped with air conditioning, a full kitchen and outdoor space. These lodges, along with Meadowlark Shelter, are reserved and rented online by clicking on **facilities** at [LinnCountyParks.com](http://LinnCountyParks.com).



**TRAILS** | A four-mile trail, which begins in the upper park area, is popular not only for hiking but also horseback riding in some areas. A portion of the trail system is groomed for cross-country skiing during the winter. A series of singletrack/mountain bike trails have been created winding through nearly 6 miles of timber and meadow.

**CAMPING** | Wanatee Park includes 69 campsites with an all-inclusive playground, modern restroom and shower facility. The campground is divided into two camping areas with sanitary dump stations nearby. B-Loop features 45 campsites with gravel pads, electricity and water hook-ups and are first come-first served. A-Loop includes 24 campsites with concrete pads, electricity and water hook-ups. 20 of these sites include hook-ups for sewer. A-Loop is the only family campground that allows advanced registrations online by clicking **facilities** at [LinnCountyParks.com](http://LinnCountyParks.com)

**Wanatee Park** is located at 1600 Banner Drive, Marion, Iowa, near the intersection of Highway 100 and Highway 13. The park was renamed in 2020 after Adeline Wanatee (1910-1996), a Meskwaki advocate for Native American and women's rights and Iowa Women's Hall of Fame honoree. The proximity to the Cedar Rapids metropolitan area and variety of wildlife makes this 998 acre park a popular destination for outdoor recreation.

**PICNICS AND PLAYGROUNDS** | Picnic areas are located at various places at Wanatee Park. Picnicking is a popular outdoor recreation activity and the wooded picnic areas offer a beautiful setting to enjoy a family outing. Playgrounds are located a short distance from Meadowlark Shelter and the campground.

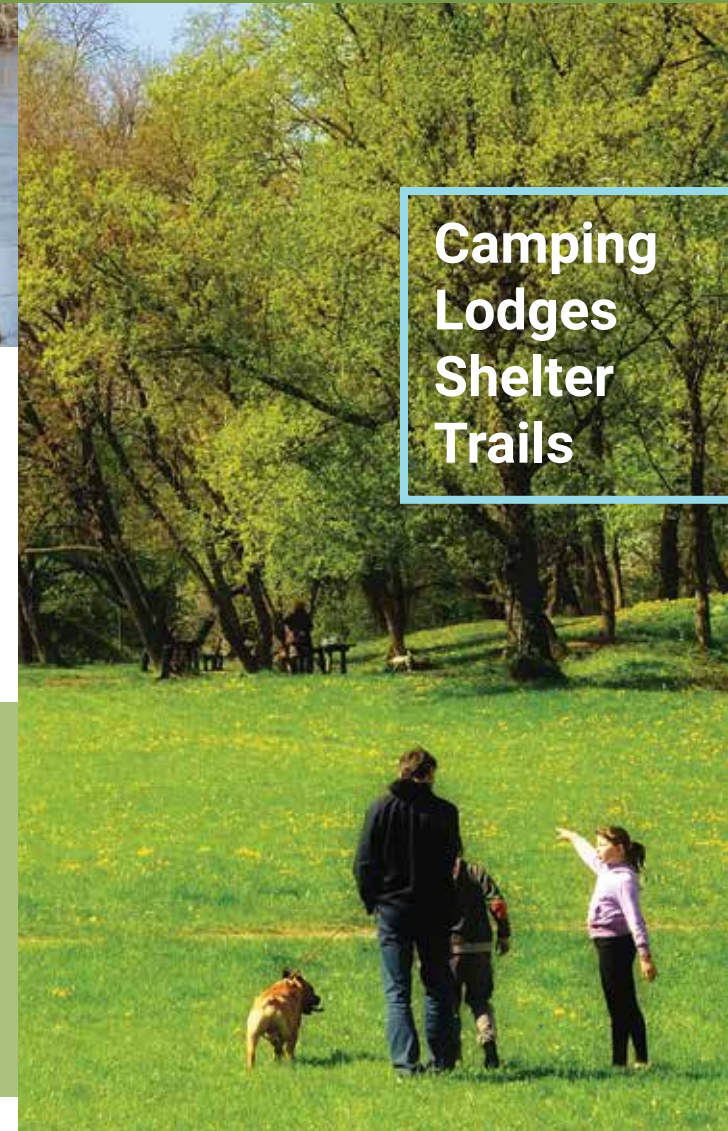

## WANATEE PARK

### Park Rules to Remember

1. Park hours are 4:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. The park closes at 10:30 p.m. except for registered campers.
2. Observe speed limits and park in designated areas only.
3. Build fires in designated areas only.
4. Keep pets on a leash and do not tie them as to cause injury to park property.
