Don't Let Your Guard Down Mask Up. Sleeves Up.

- ➔ **Vaccines are effective and safe.**
- ➔ **Vaccine supplies are limited, so be patient and continue to wear a mask, wash hands and maintain social distance.**
- ➔ **Help Linn County Public Health by staying informed and not listening to rumors.**

Linn County Public Health strongly recommends you mask up and don't let your guard down prior to and after vaccination.

Vaccine facts to know:

- There is not just one registration area for vaccines. We know that is frustrating, but remember, there are nearly 230,000 people living in Linn County.
- Mercy, UnityPoint Health, Eastern Iowa Health Center will contact you when they have vaccine for patients. If you do not have a provider, call Linn County Public Health.
- You still need to wear a mask after you receive your vaccine.
