

If you are getting an error message when extracting your files that references “Path Too Long” this isn’t an issue with the downloaded zip file. It’s an issue with the program you use to unzip the file along with where you are saving the file too. Usually this error is caused when you use Windows Explorer or WinZip to extract files and it encounters a file path that exceeds the maximum character limit (128 characters).

Here are a few things you can try:

1 - Copy it to the root of your C: drive then extract it. You can still extract it to wherever you want but start it from the root of your C: drive.

2 - Rename the zip file (SRCR111111 – Jonathan Doe.zip) to something short like JD.zip or something like that.

3 - Download the 7-zip program and use that to extract them. This program allows for long paths and file names.

4 – Contact your IT people they should be able to help more if needed.
